Seven deadly sins

1. Lifting a load incorrectly



e.g. manhole covers

2. Lowering



e.g. laying kerb stones

3. Carrying a load



e.g. cement bags

4. Pushing



e.g. loads of aggregate

5. Pulling



e.g. blocks and slabs

6. Twisting



e.g. handling and positioning plasterboard

7. Holding



e.g. supporting a load when fixing into position
